

1. absolut must: climb the roof of the Duomo. It really is not to be missed and absolutely unique ... or have lunch at the top floor of Rinascente where you have the view on it
2. while you are in piazza Duomo have a look at the storical bar Camparino at the corner with the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele. The liberty mosaic work inside is stunning. Good place for aperitivo (but closed on monday) ... but do as the Milanese and have it standing ... not sitting
3. ride the old tram with wooden seats. I think they are pre-war. For example nr.19 or 23 since I am a designer here a few "design tips"
4. visit the studio of Achille Castiglioni (one of the most famous Italian design icons) <http://www.achillecastiglioni.it/it/studio.html>
5. check out corso Monforte with the showrooms of Cappellini, Flos, Artemide and Luceplan and via Durini with B&B Italia, Cassina and around the corner in via Cavalotti Cerruti Baleri
6. the spaces of Rossana Orlandi who is considered a kind of style-guru <http://www.rossanaorlandi.com/>
7. also the museum of Kartell is very interesting but maybe a bit too far out <http://www.kartell.it/>
8. visit the 31st floor of the Pirelli building one of the great architectural achievements of Gio Ponti ( <http://www.grattacielopirelli31.com/eng%5F2/>) but I am not sure if it is always possible in alternative go up the Torre Branca [http://www.fps-eventi.it/torre\\_branca\\_4.html](http://www.fps-eventi.it/torre_branca_4.html) and have a stroll through Parco Sempione.
