



ENERGY SAVING MEASURES OF THE CITY OF GREVENMACHER

Outdoor swimming pool of the City of Grevenmacher:

Due to the recommendations of the government and the European Union to take energy saving measures, the council of aldermen decided this year to close the outdoor swimming pool on September 9th, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. (instead of September 30th).

With this measure, the City of Grevenmacher saves:



17.138m³ gas

corresponds to the average annual consumption of **5 households**.



37.800kWh electricity

corresponds to the average annual consumption of **10 households**.



2.880m³ water

corresponds to the average annual consumption of **19 households**.

Further energy saving measures by the City of Grevenmacher:

- Lighting of public buildings and monuments will be switched off after 10.00 p.m.
- Switching off decorative ground spotlights.
- Continuous conversion to energy-saving LED street lighting.
- ▶ Lowering the brightness of night lighting in various streets by 60%.
- Optimization of heating systems in public buildings.

The City of Grevenmacher continues to invest in modern lighting and heating systems to prevent energy waste in the municipality.
